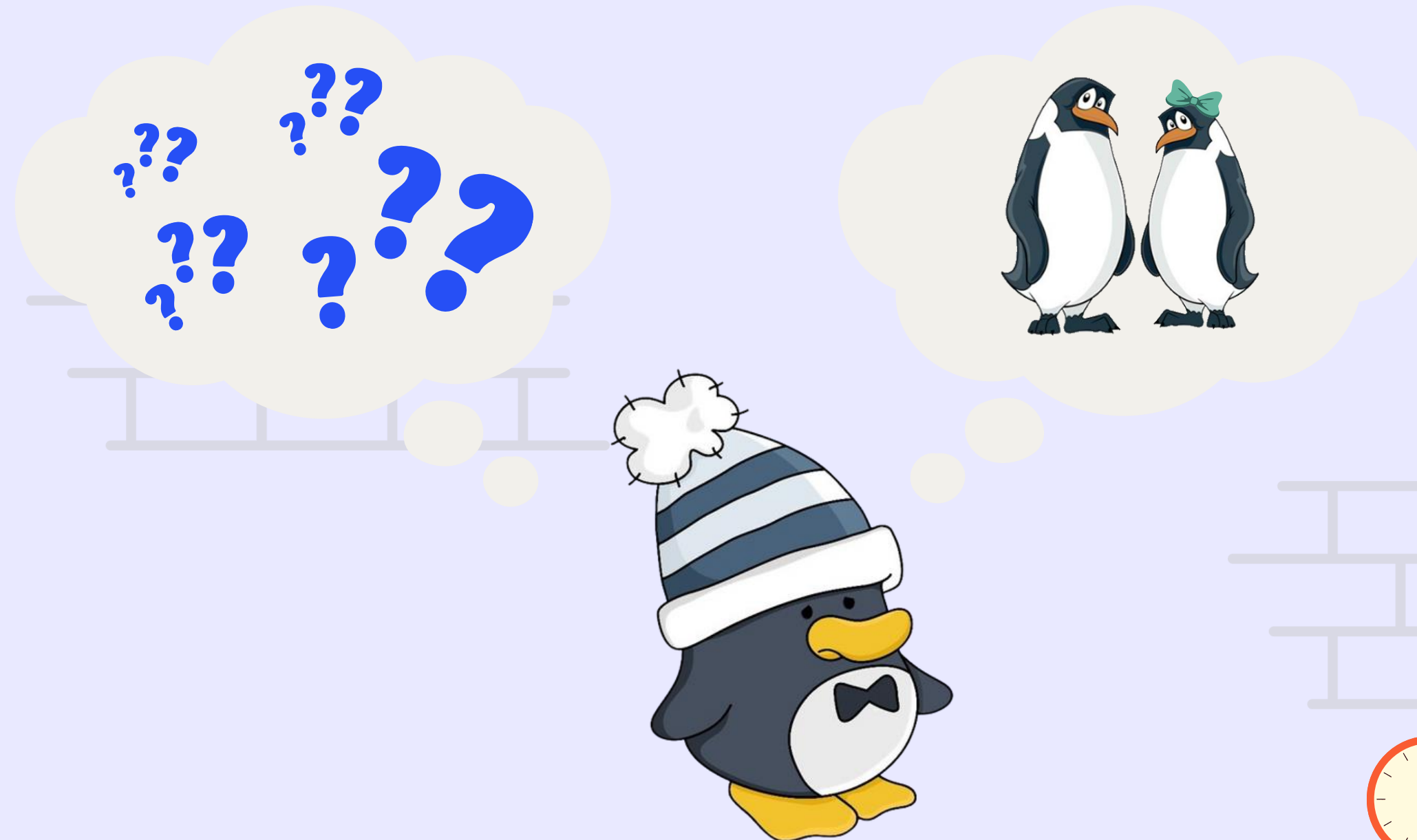


Oh no! What should I do?

Should he try to fix the problem by himself and get rid of the picture, or should he ask his parents for help?

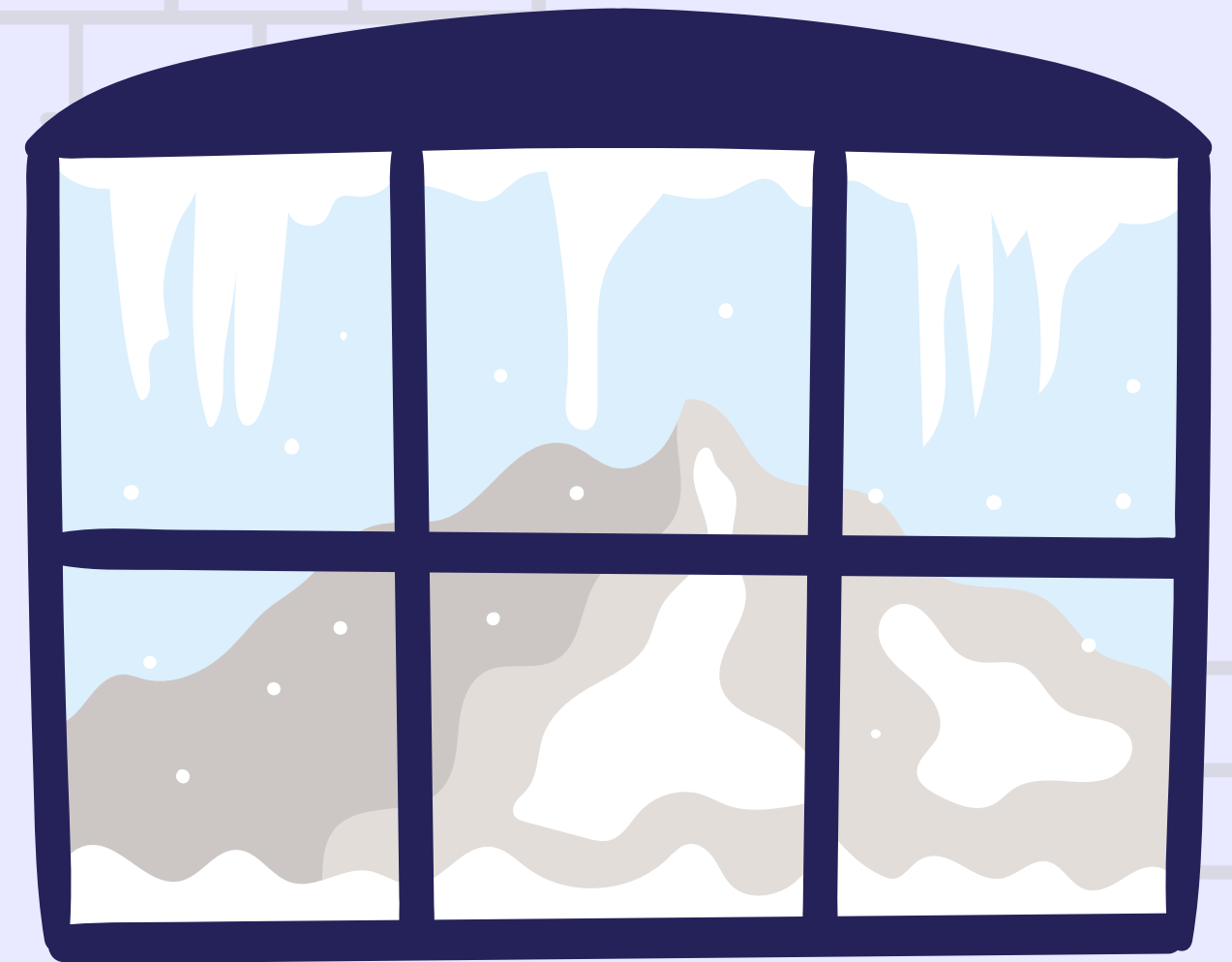


Time to chat!

"Help!" cried Smartie. "Daddy, Mummy, please help me! Something scary has happened. There's a picture on my screen and I don't want to see it."

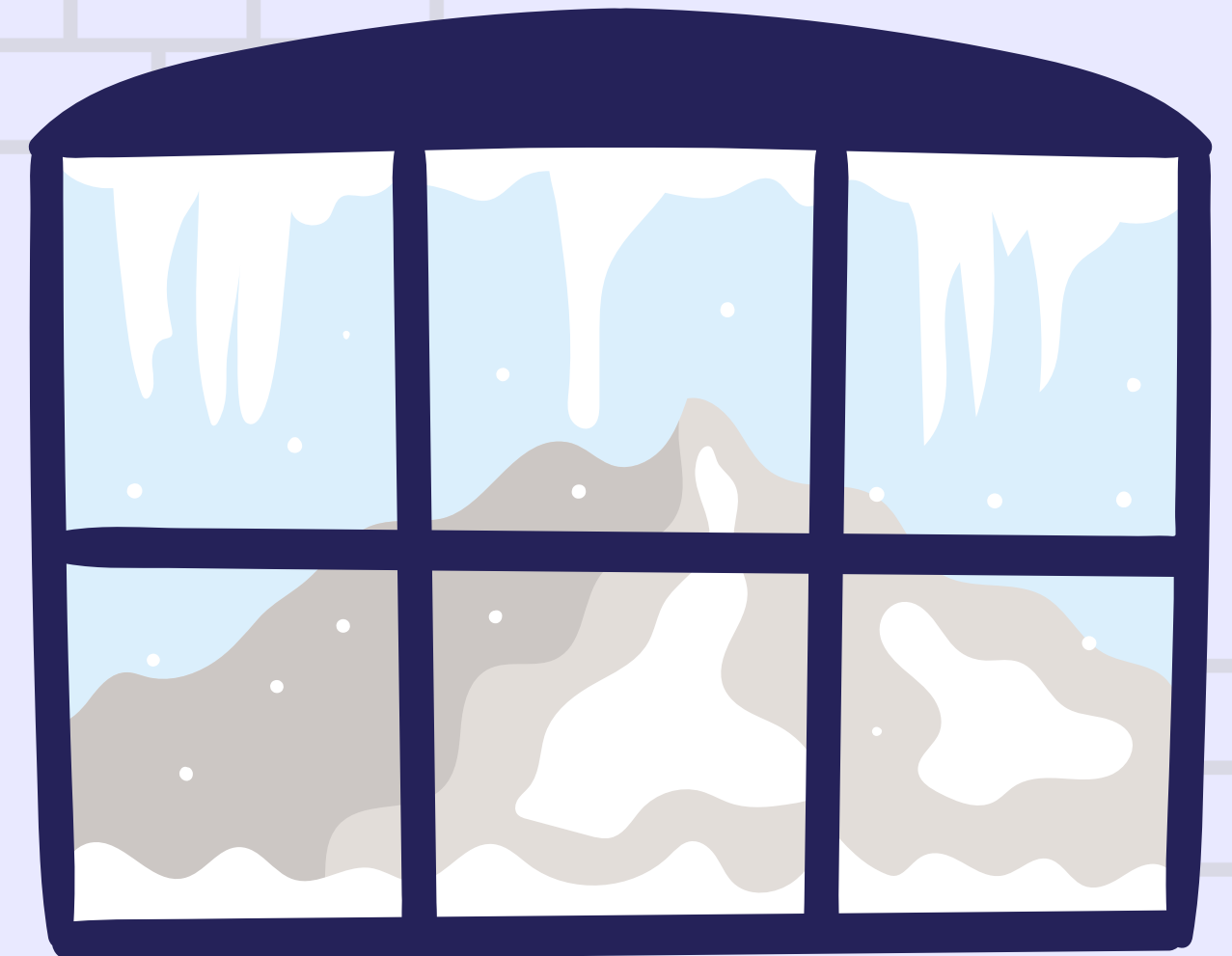
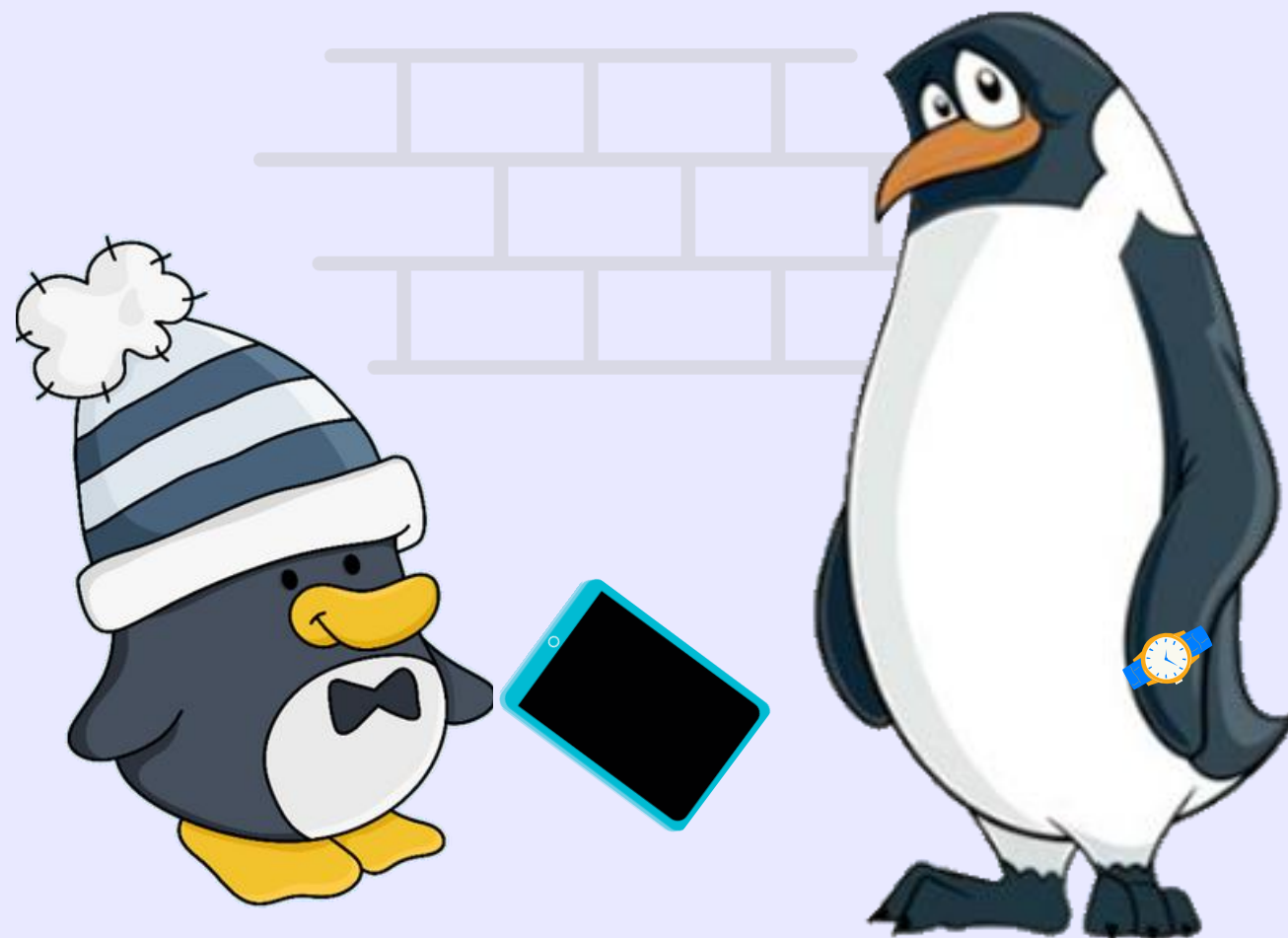


HELP!



"Well done, Smartie," said Daddy Penguin.

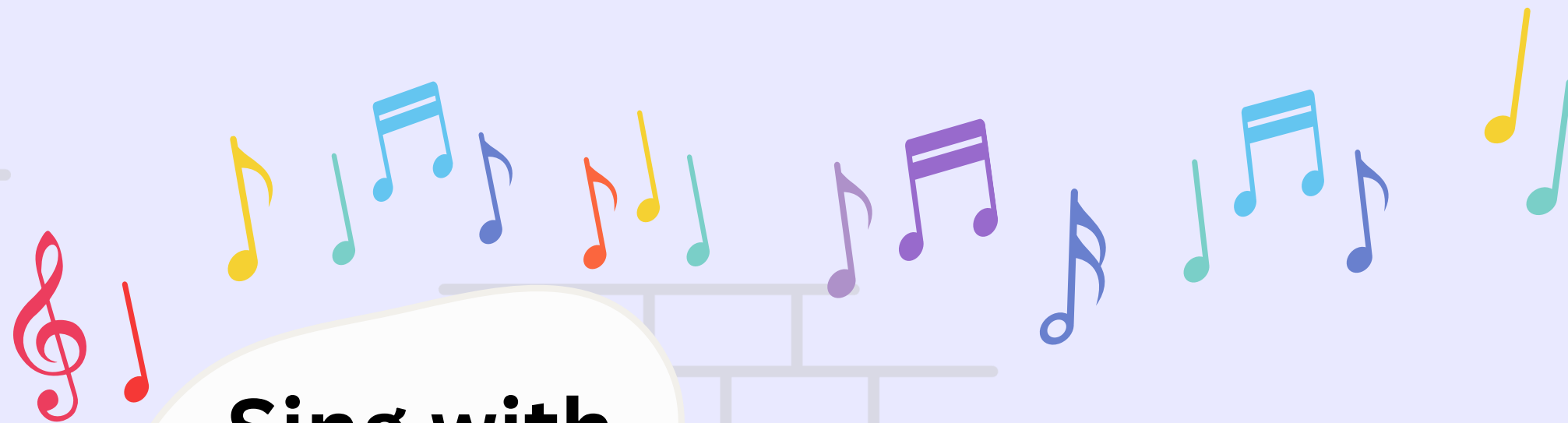
"You made the right choice by asking for help and not trying to fix it by yourself."

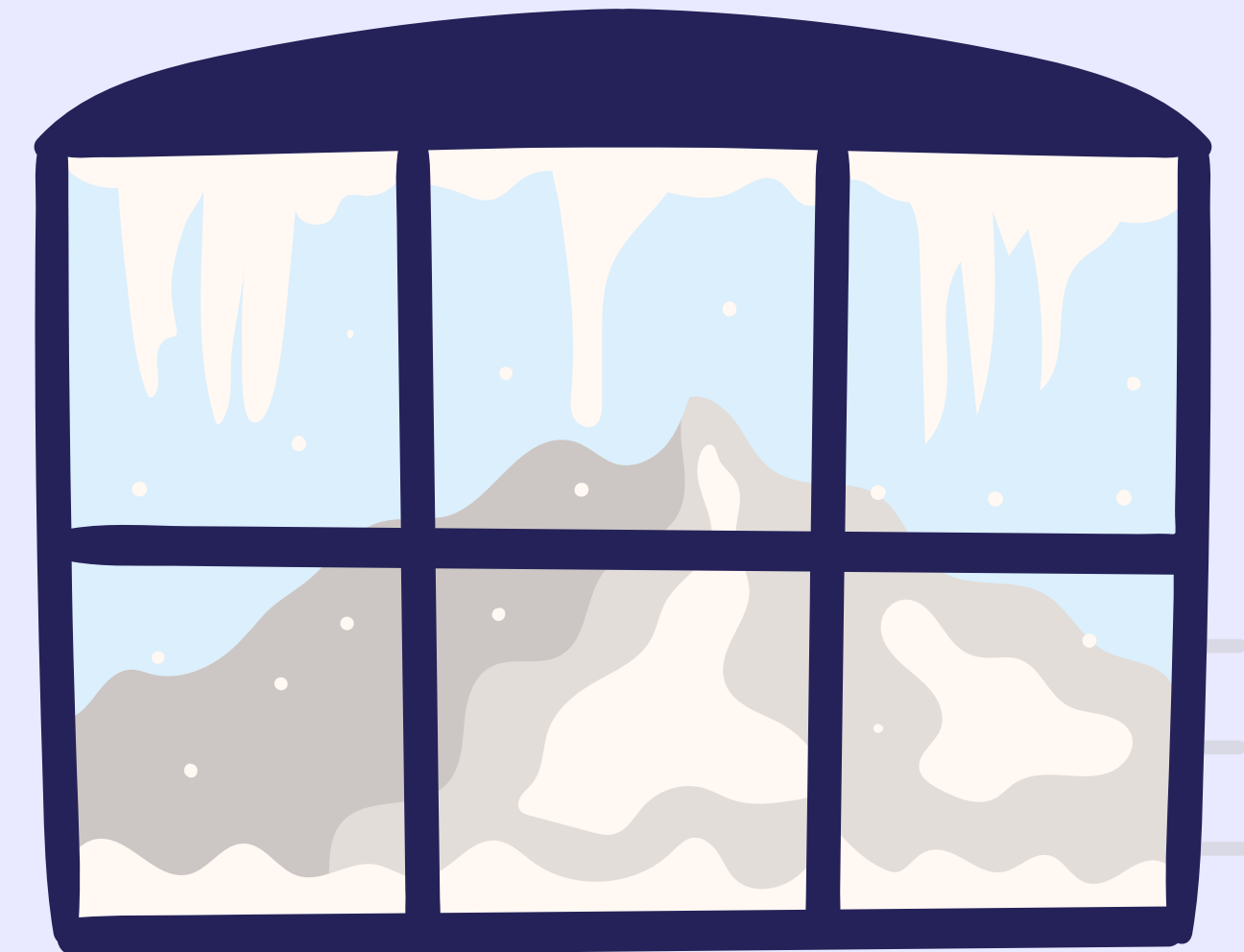

Mummy Penguin deleted the picture that had popped up and changed the settings on the tablet, to help make sure that Smartie would only see pictures that were right for him.

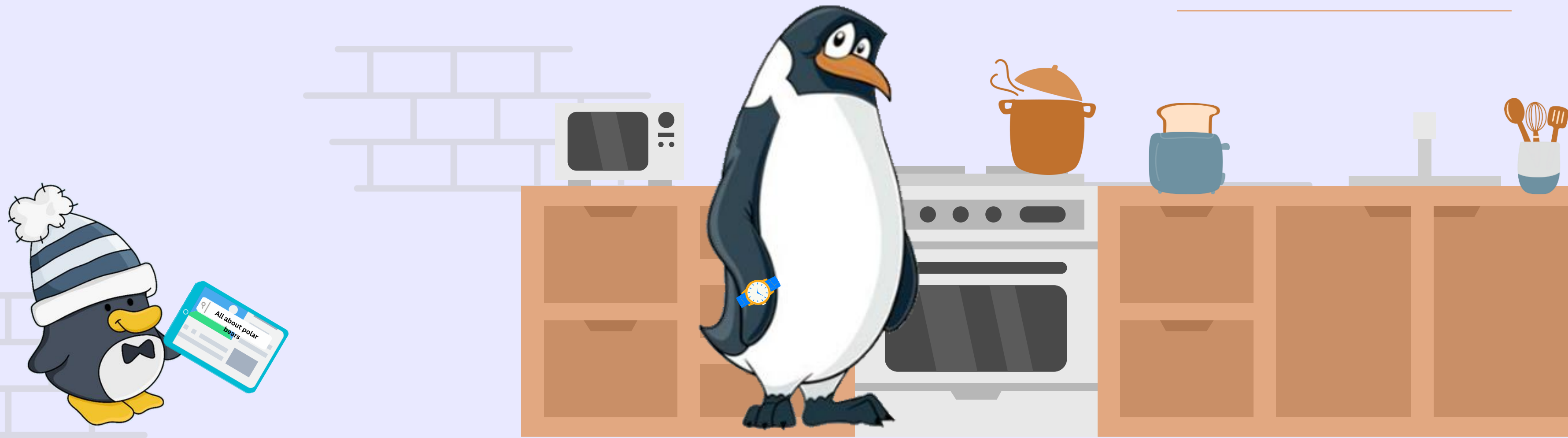


**Thank you,

"Help!" shouted Smartie. "Mummy, Daddy, please help me. I'm trying to find out more about polar bears, but the information doesn't sound right!"

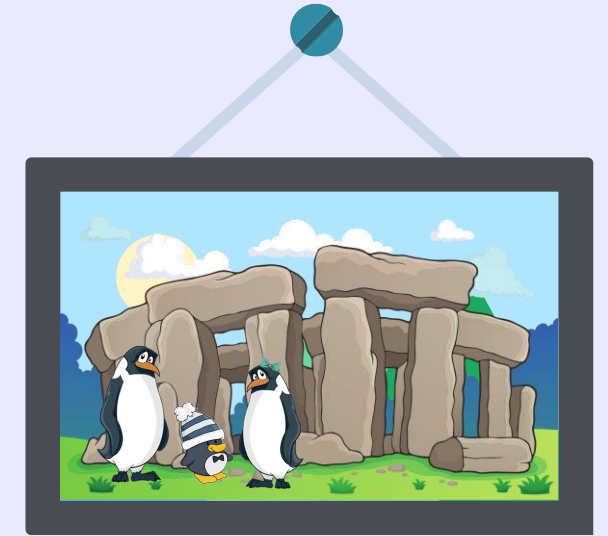

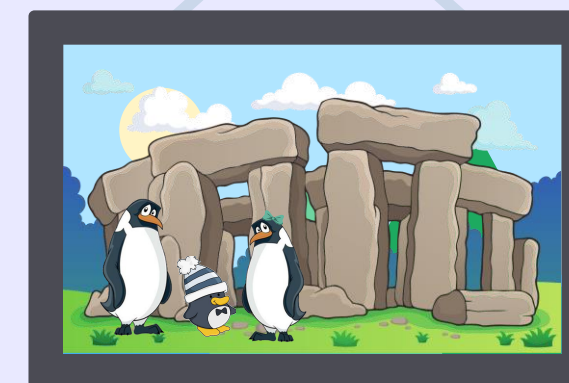
"Smartie," replied Mummy Penguin, "You made a fantastic choice! Not everything online is true, so it is always best to check with a grown up first."

Mummy Penguin helped Smartie to find the right information and everything was fine again.

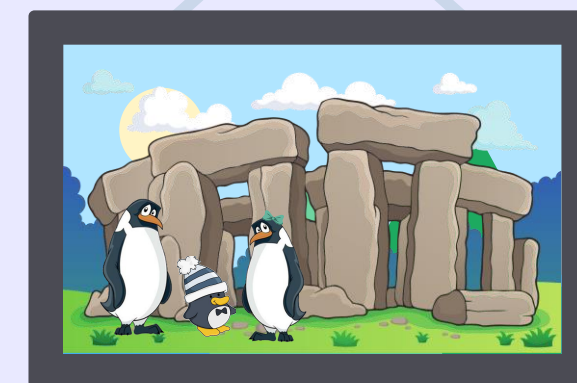


Later on that afternoon... Can you guess what Smartie was doing?

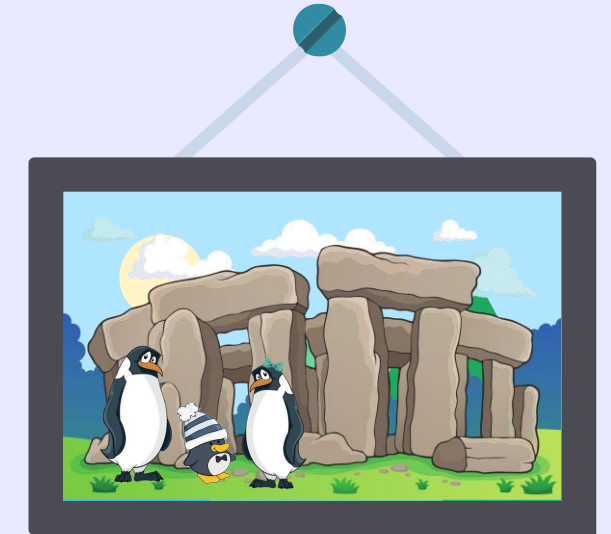
That's right! Smartie was back on his tablet playing his favourite game, Snowcraft. He was getting better and better and trying to beat his top score from yesterday.

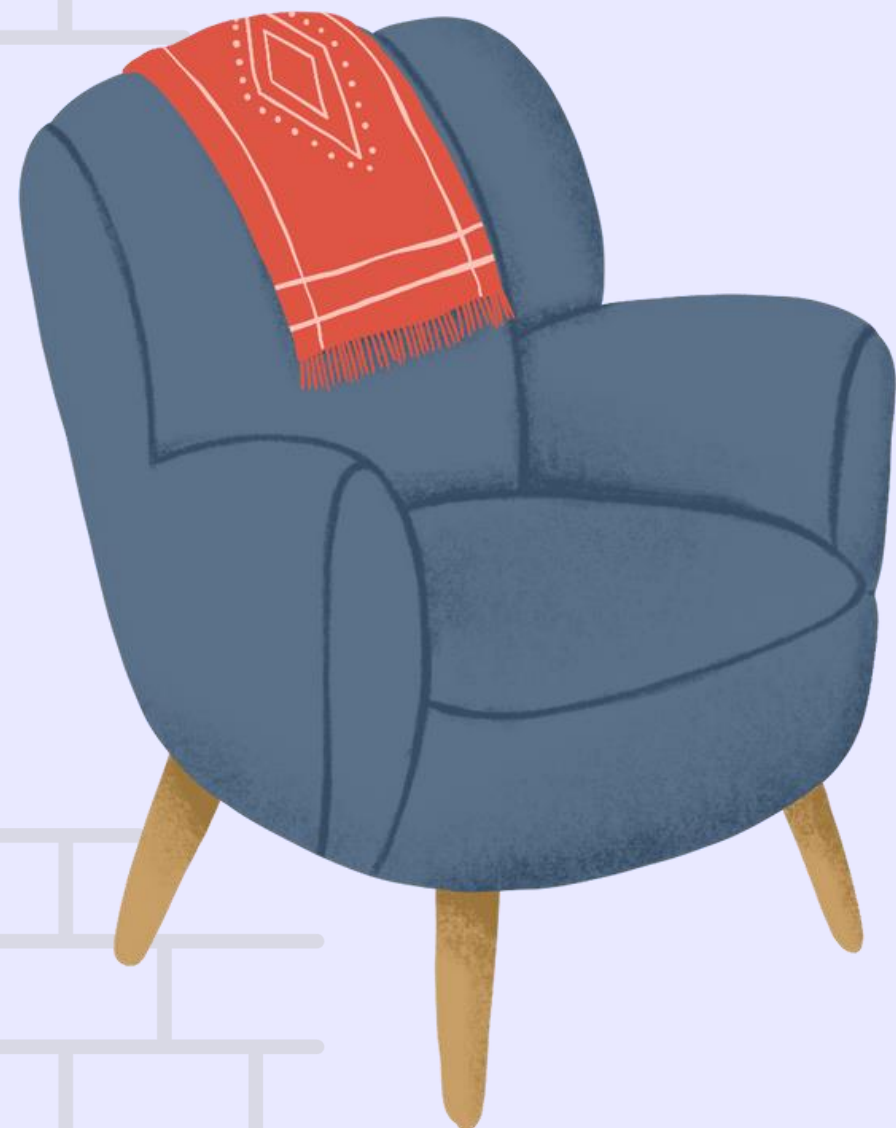

"Daddy, Mummy!" called Smartie.

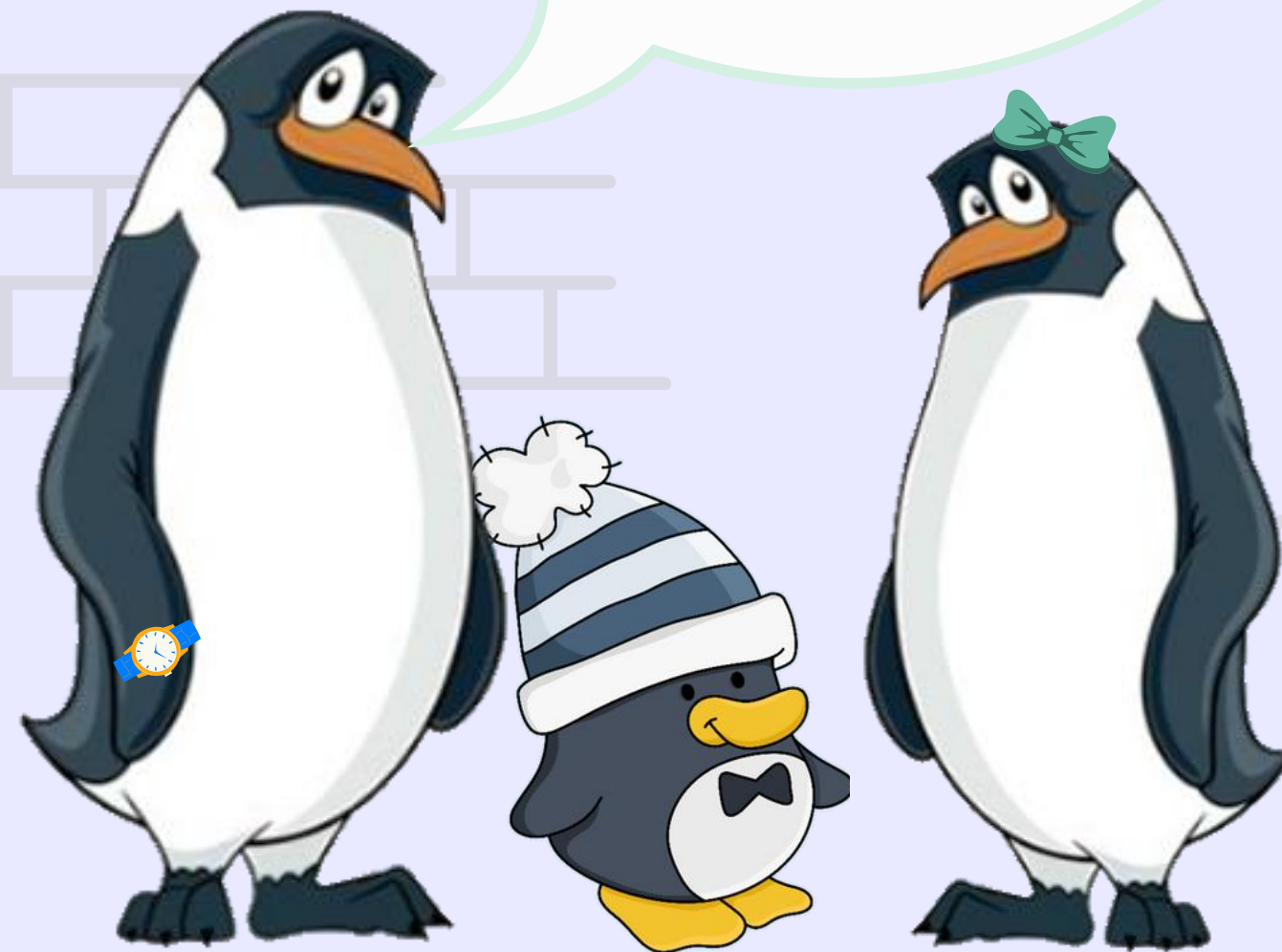
"Someone is trying to talk to me, and I don't know them. What shall I do?"



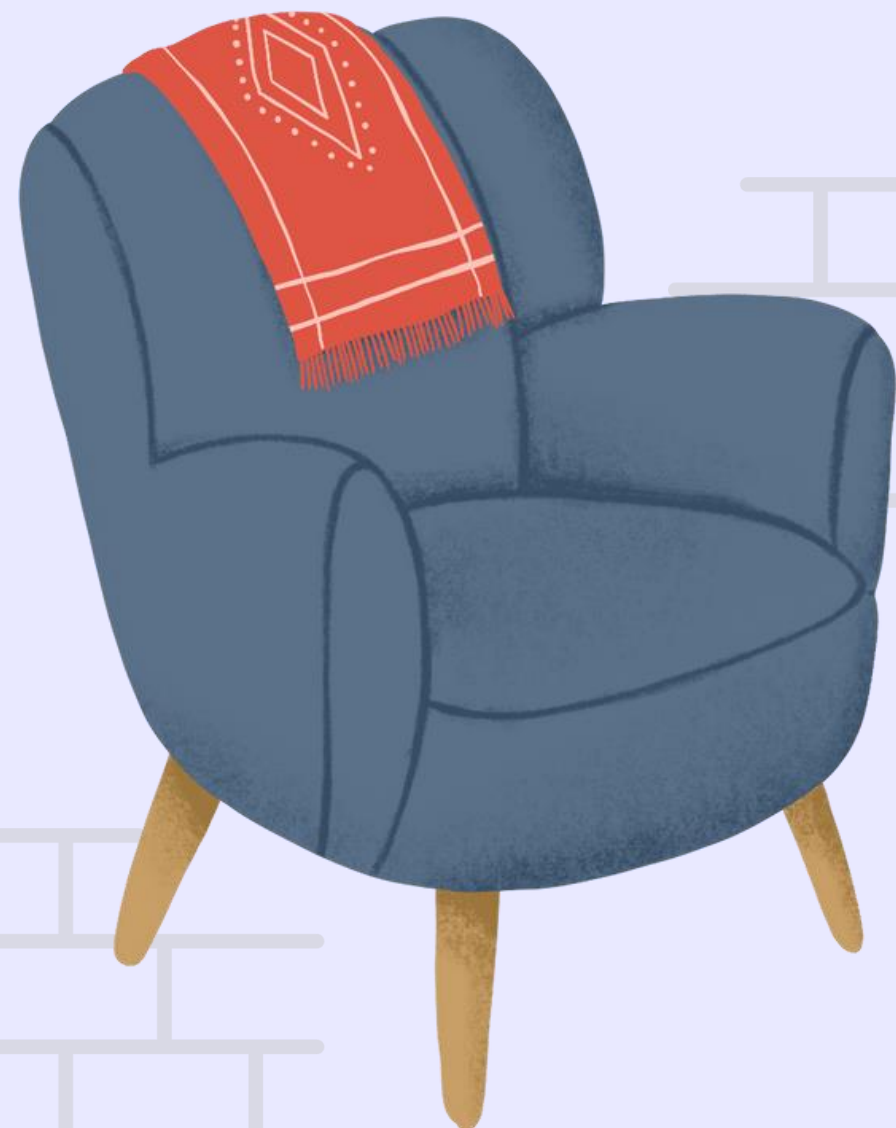
**Daddy,

"Oh Smartie, coming to tell us was such a sensible choice," said Daddy Penguin.

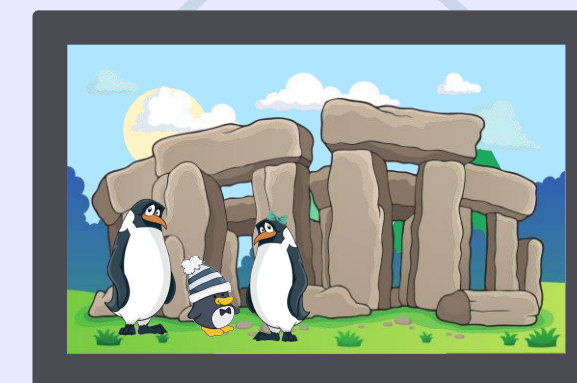
**Well done,
