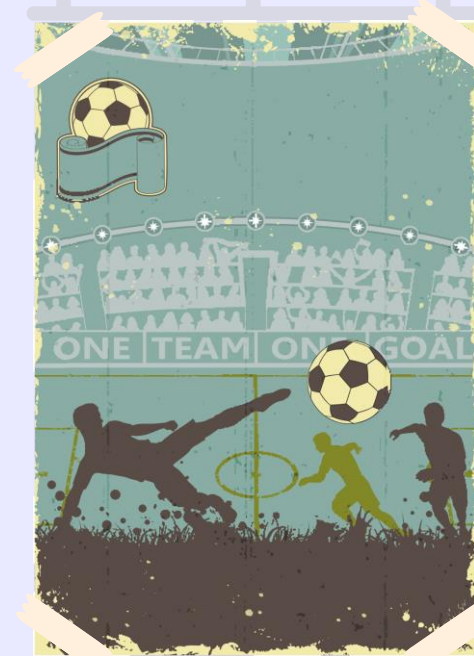

# The Adventures of Smartie the Penguin

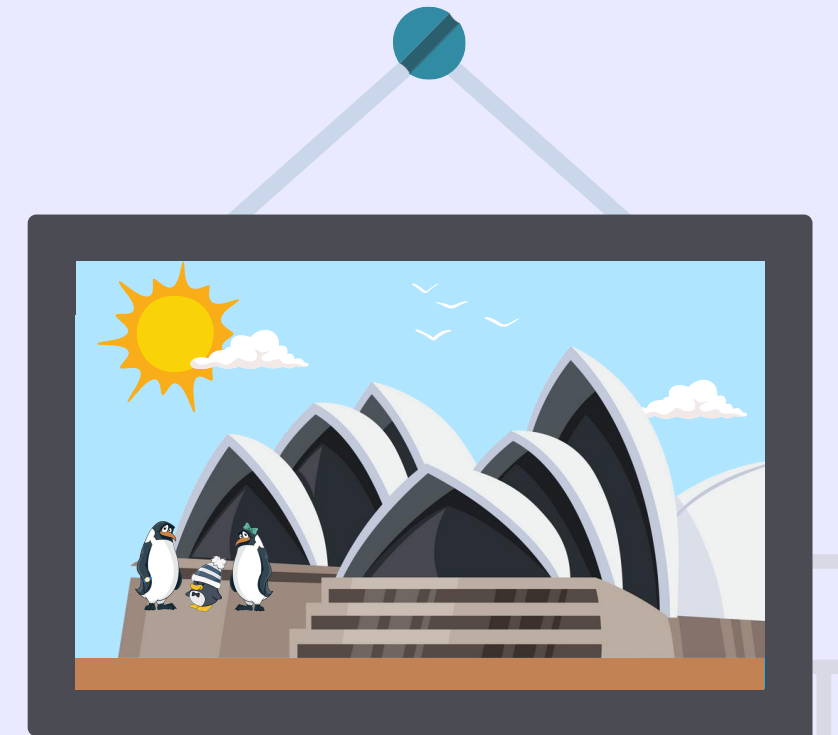


One sunny morning, Smartie the Penguin woke up with a spring in his step. He could not wait to go downstairs and start playing on his tablet!



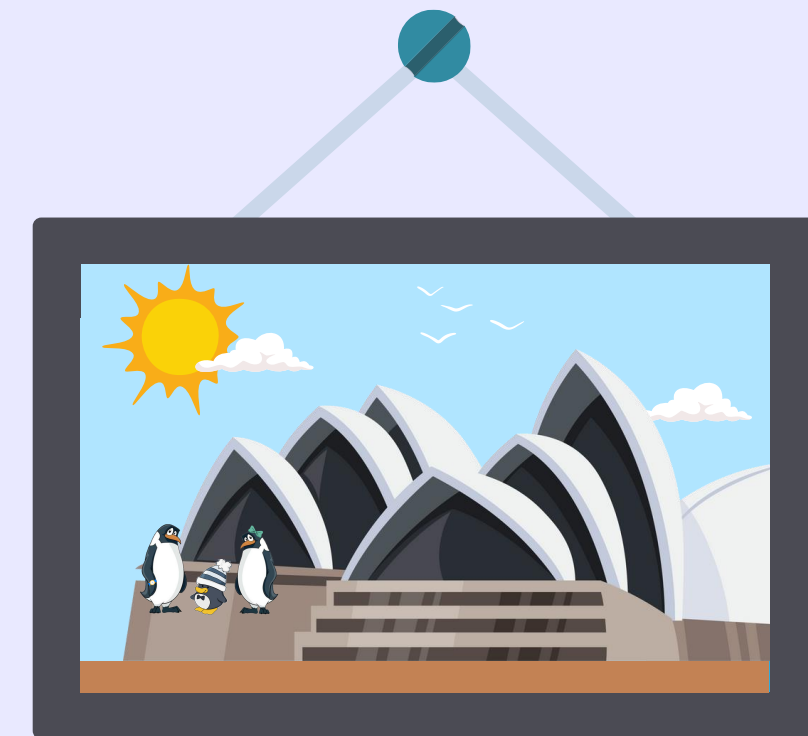
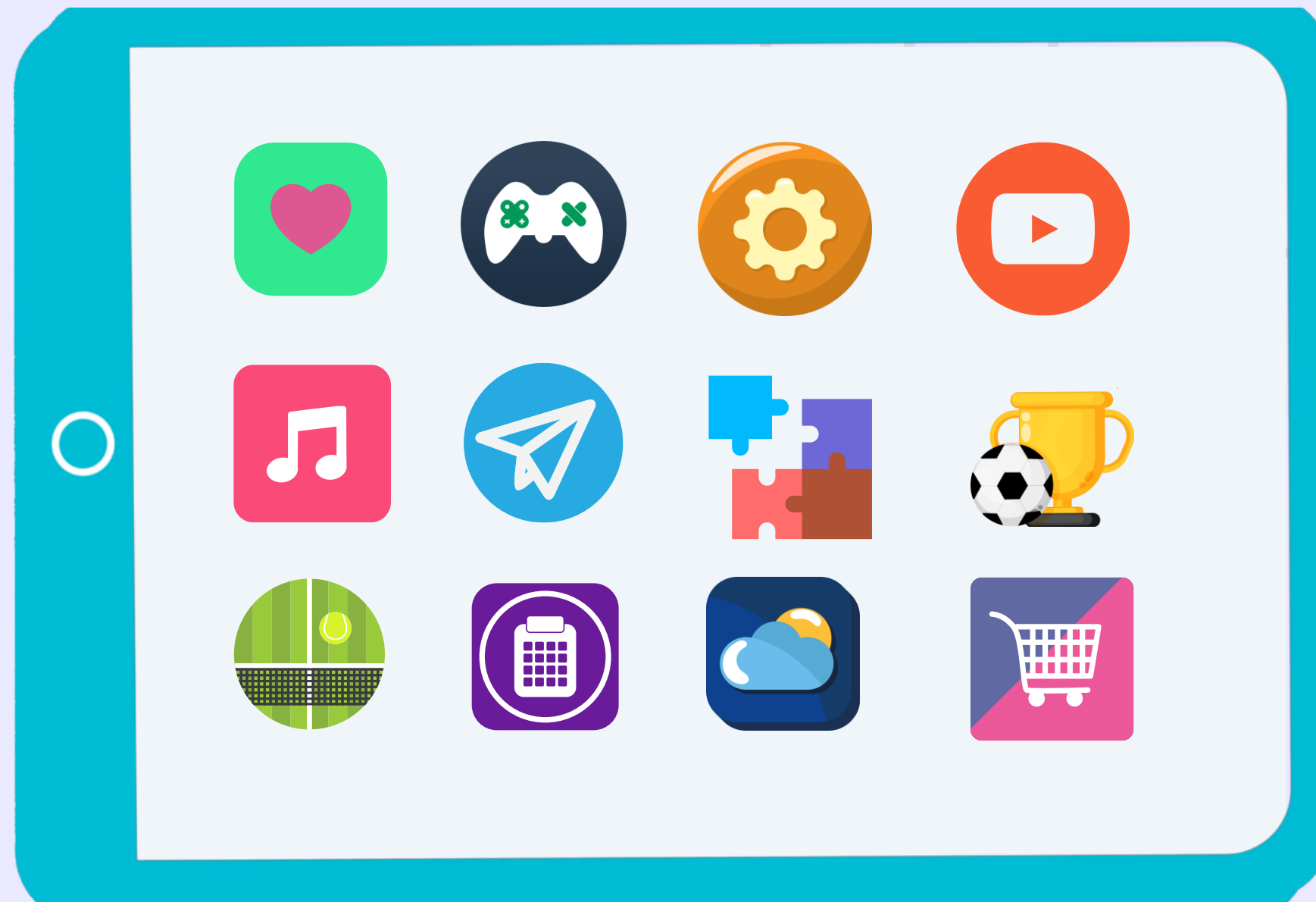
Smartie said good morning to Mummy and Daddy Penguin and asked if he was allowed to go on the tablet.

"Yes, of course!" Daddy Penguin replied. In a flash, Smartie darted to the living room to grab it.


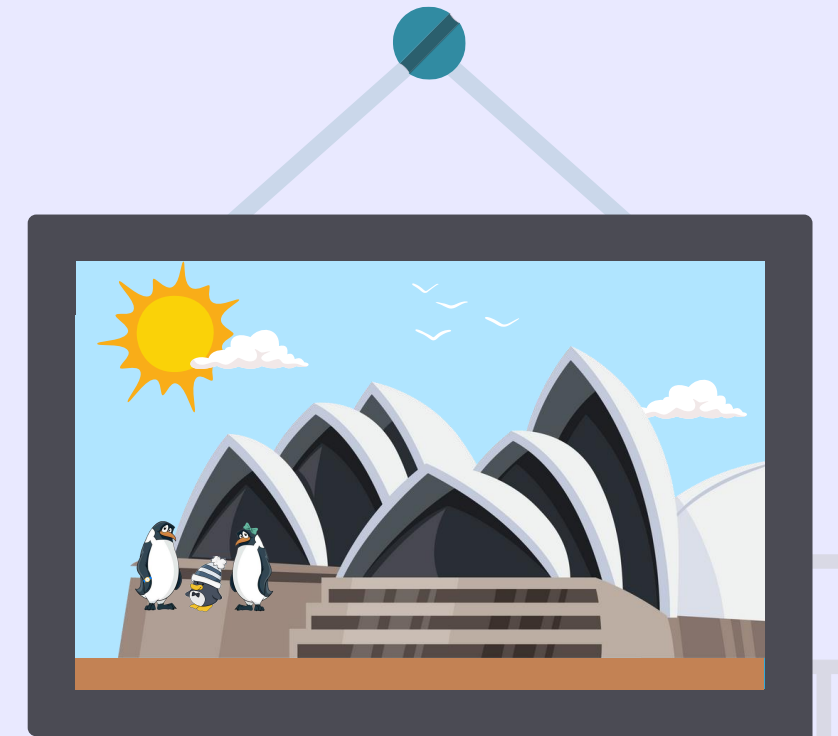





Smartie scrolled through the apps and games on his tablet and sighed.


"I've played these LOADS of times; I want to find something new!"

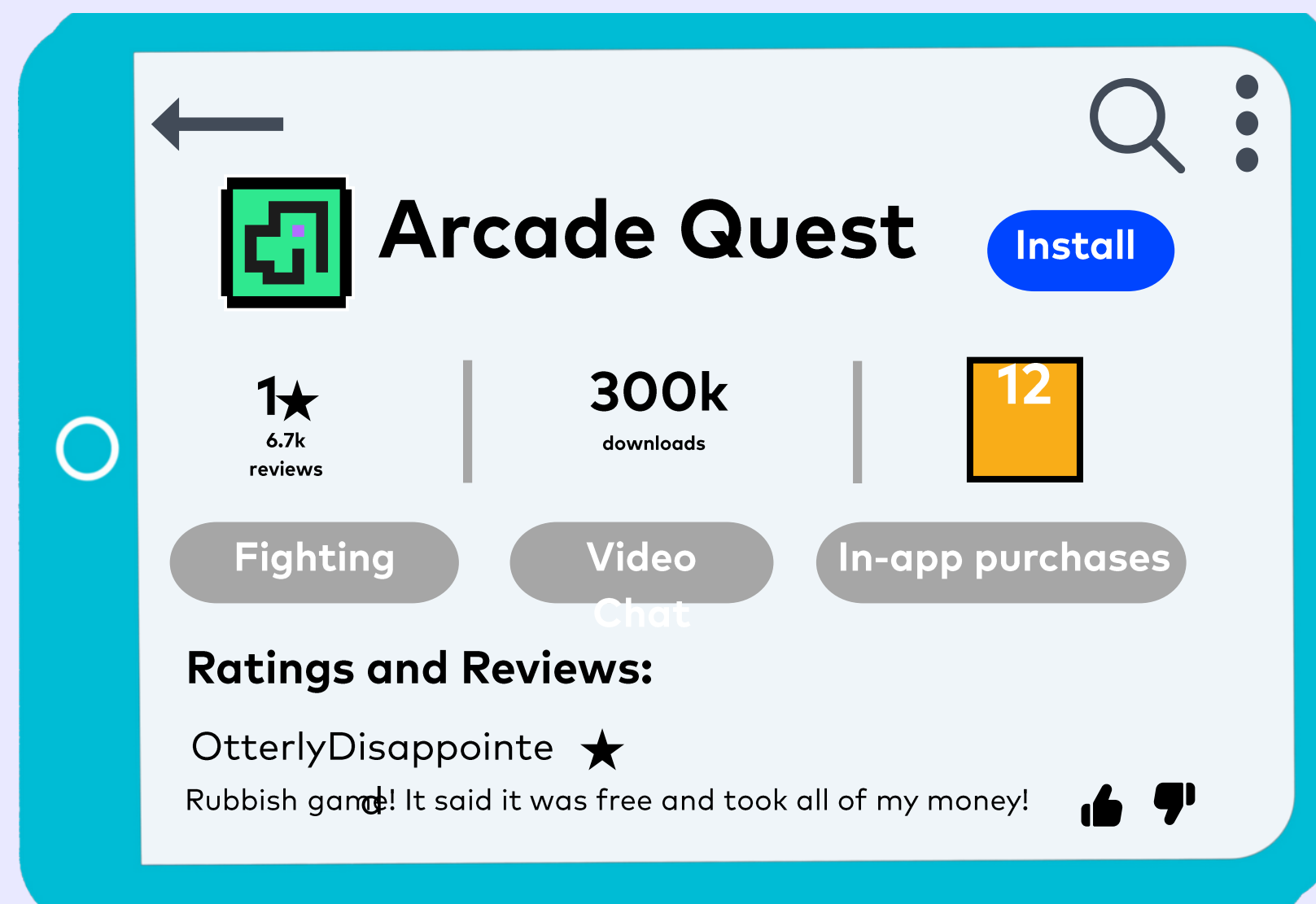
Can you help Smartie make the right decision?

Mummy Penguin helped Smartie find a new game to play, which was more suitable for him.

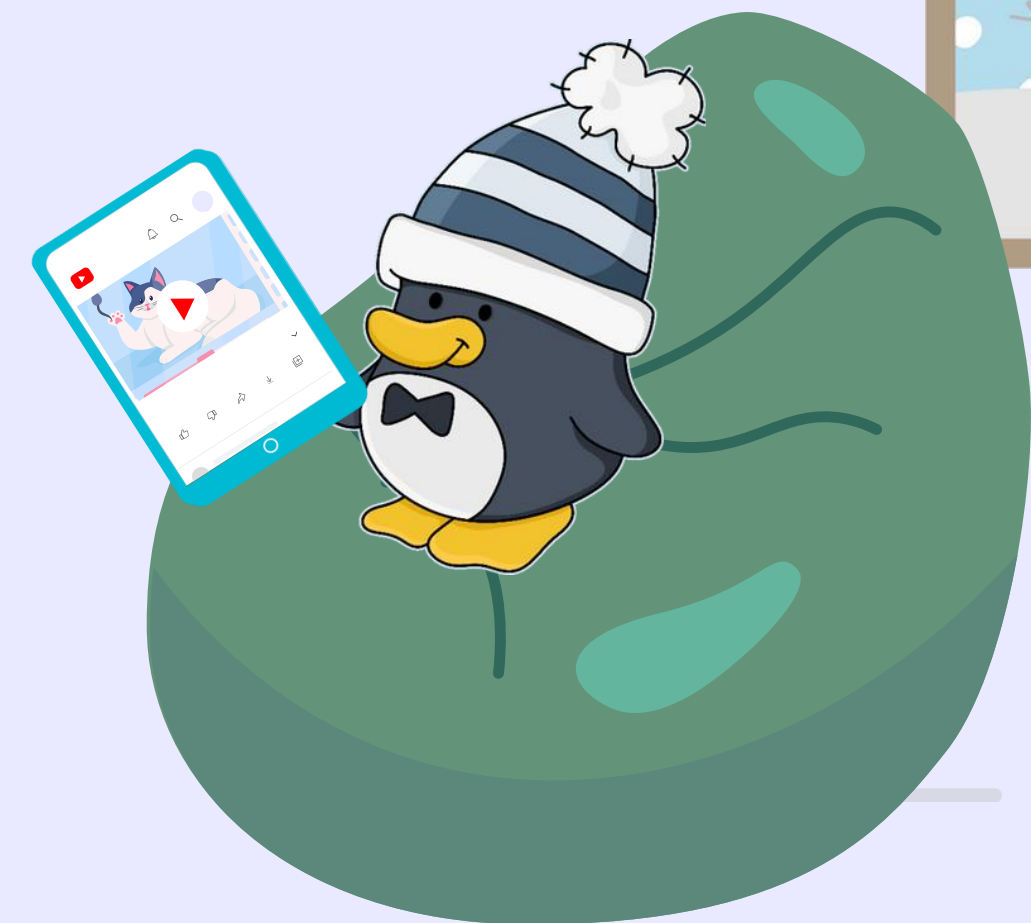

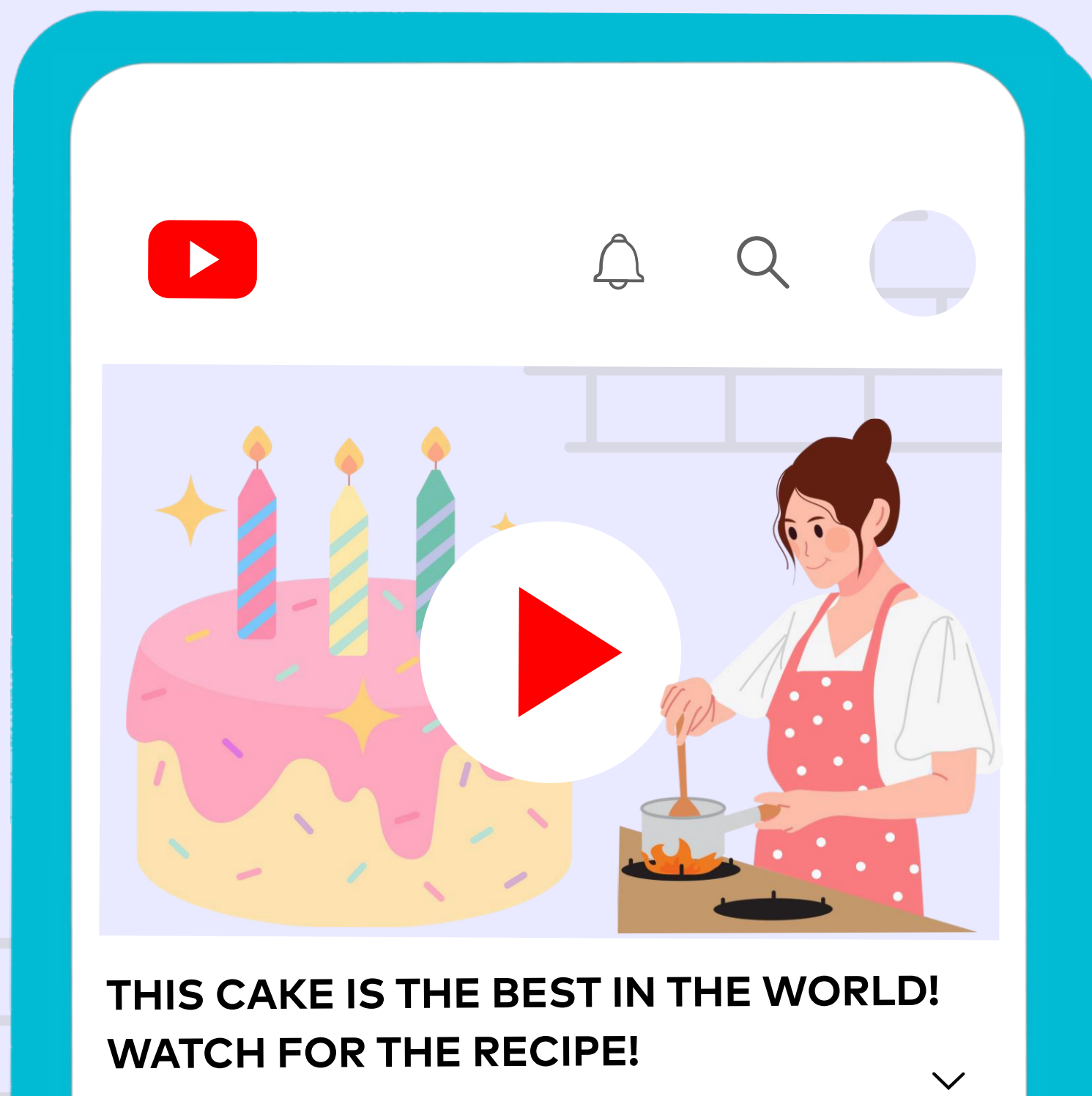


Later on that day, Smartie had been playing tennis all afternoon and he wanted to take a break to go on his tablet.

When he was searching, he came across a video with the title: 'THIS CAKE IS THE BEST IN THE WORLD! WATCH FOR THE RECIPE!'

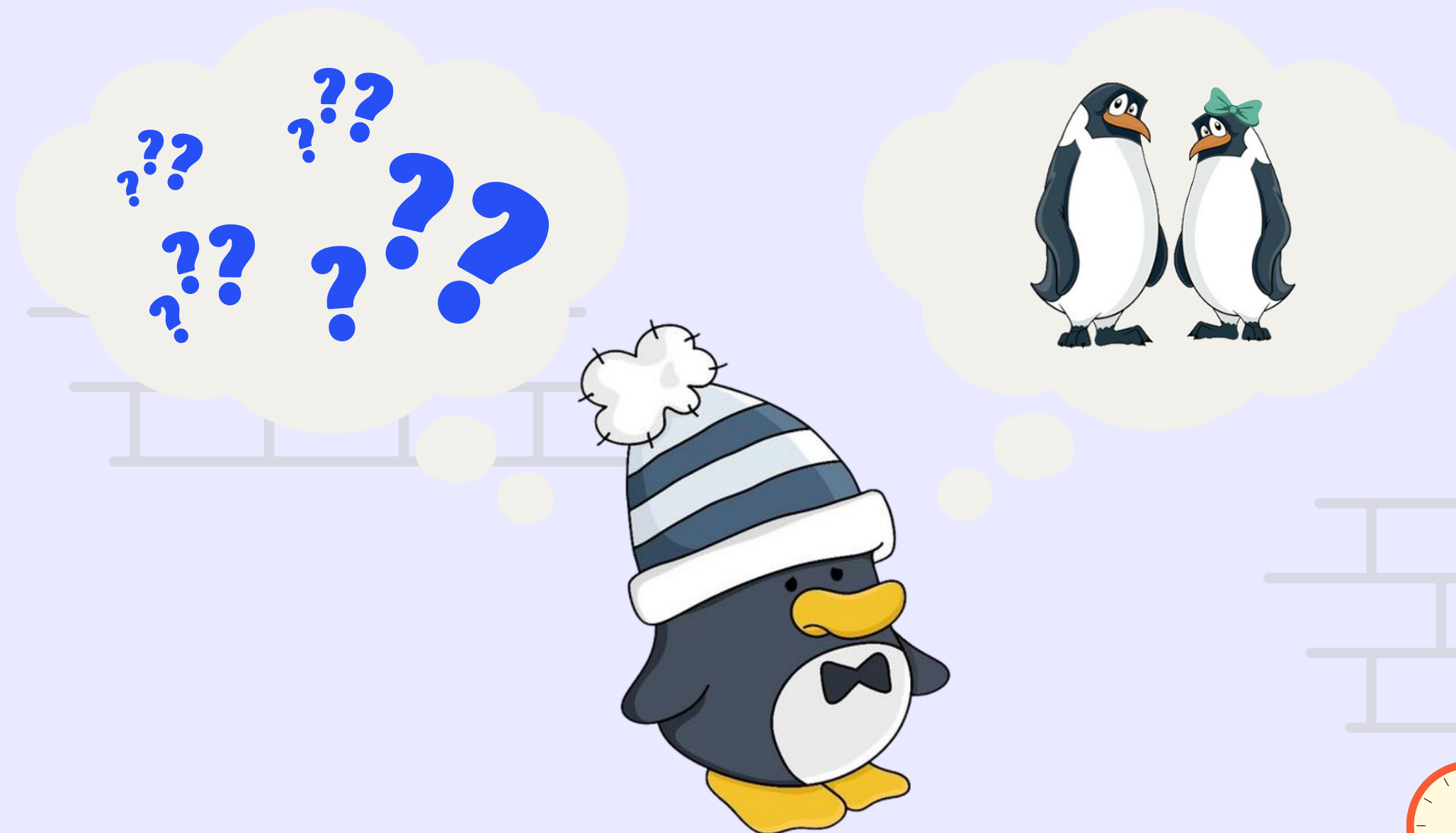

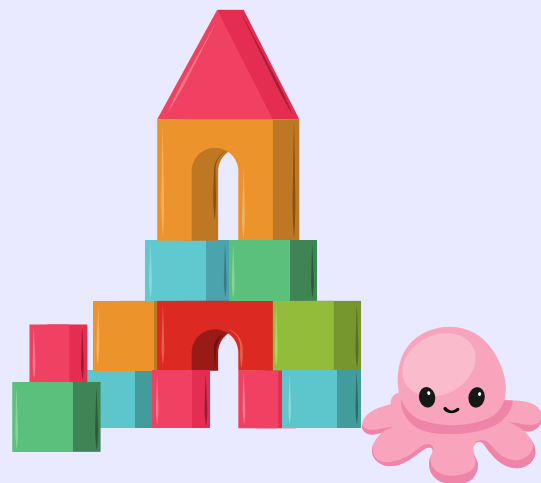

"Smartie, well done for checking!" said Mummy Penguin. "This is called an opinion. This is just what somebody thinks, it is not truthful for everyone."

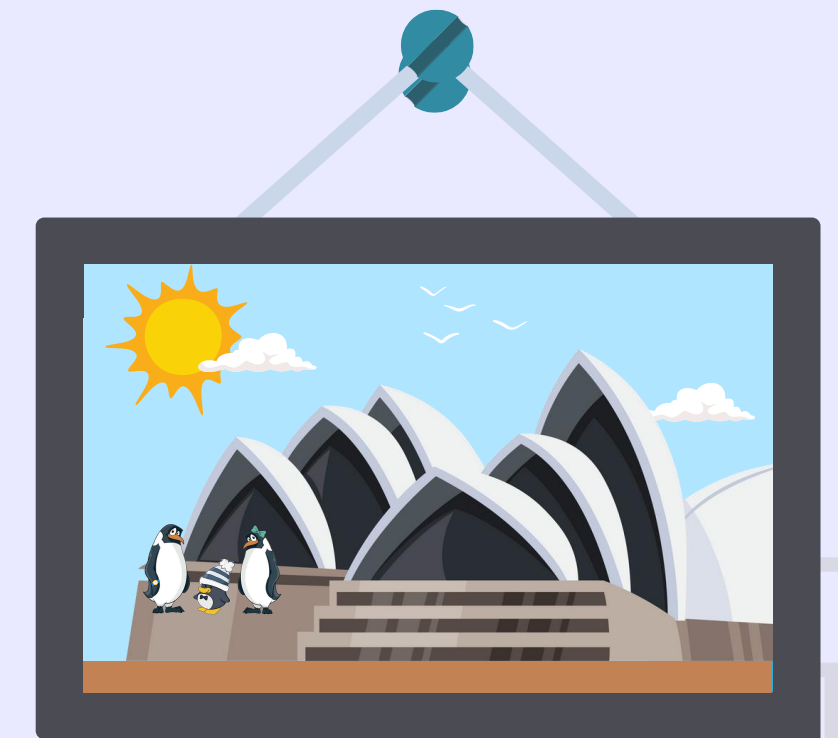
"Just because they think it's the best cake in the world, does not mean you have to agree with them," said Daddy Penguin.



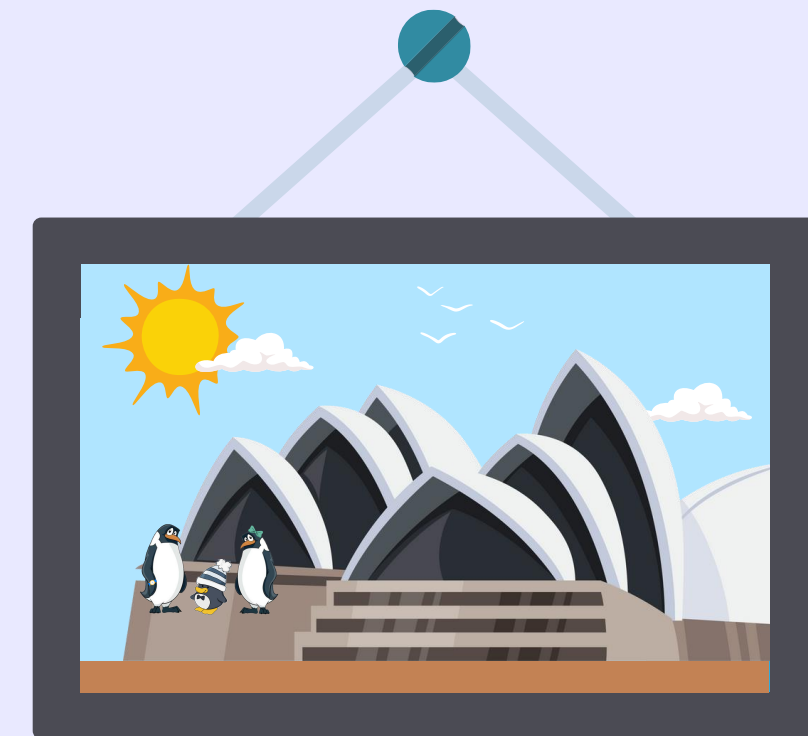
Mummy Penguin and Smartie watched the video together. It was interesting to find out about someone else's opinion, but he was still sure that his favourite cake was the tastiest!



The next day, Smartie was back on his tablet playing his favourite game, Snowcraft. He was getting better and better and trying to beat his top score from yesterday.

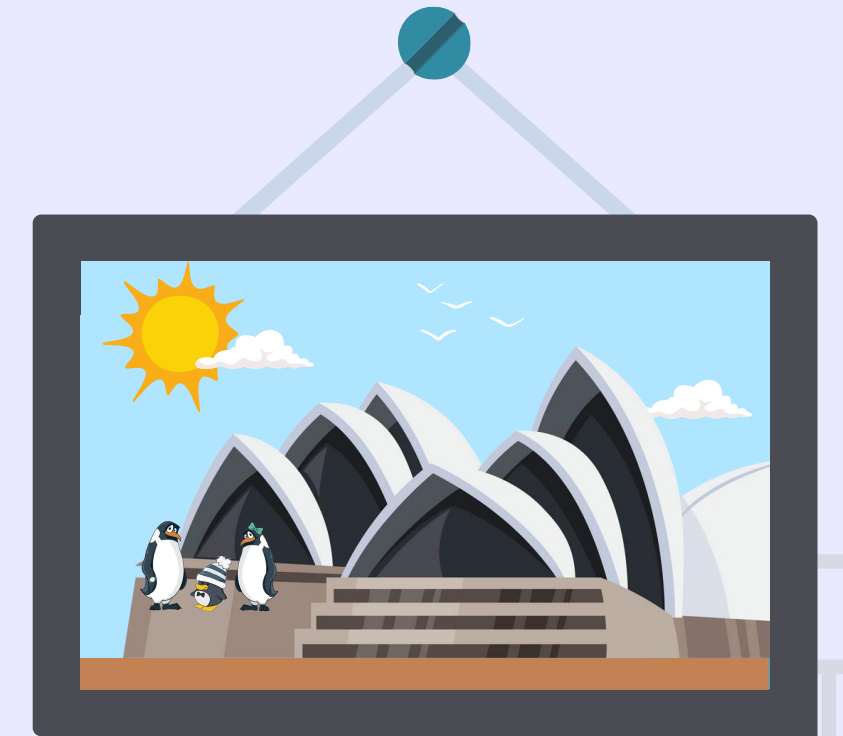


All of a sudden, the tablet beeped, and a message appeared on the screen. It was someone that often played the same games as Smartie, so he was excited to see them online again.



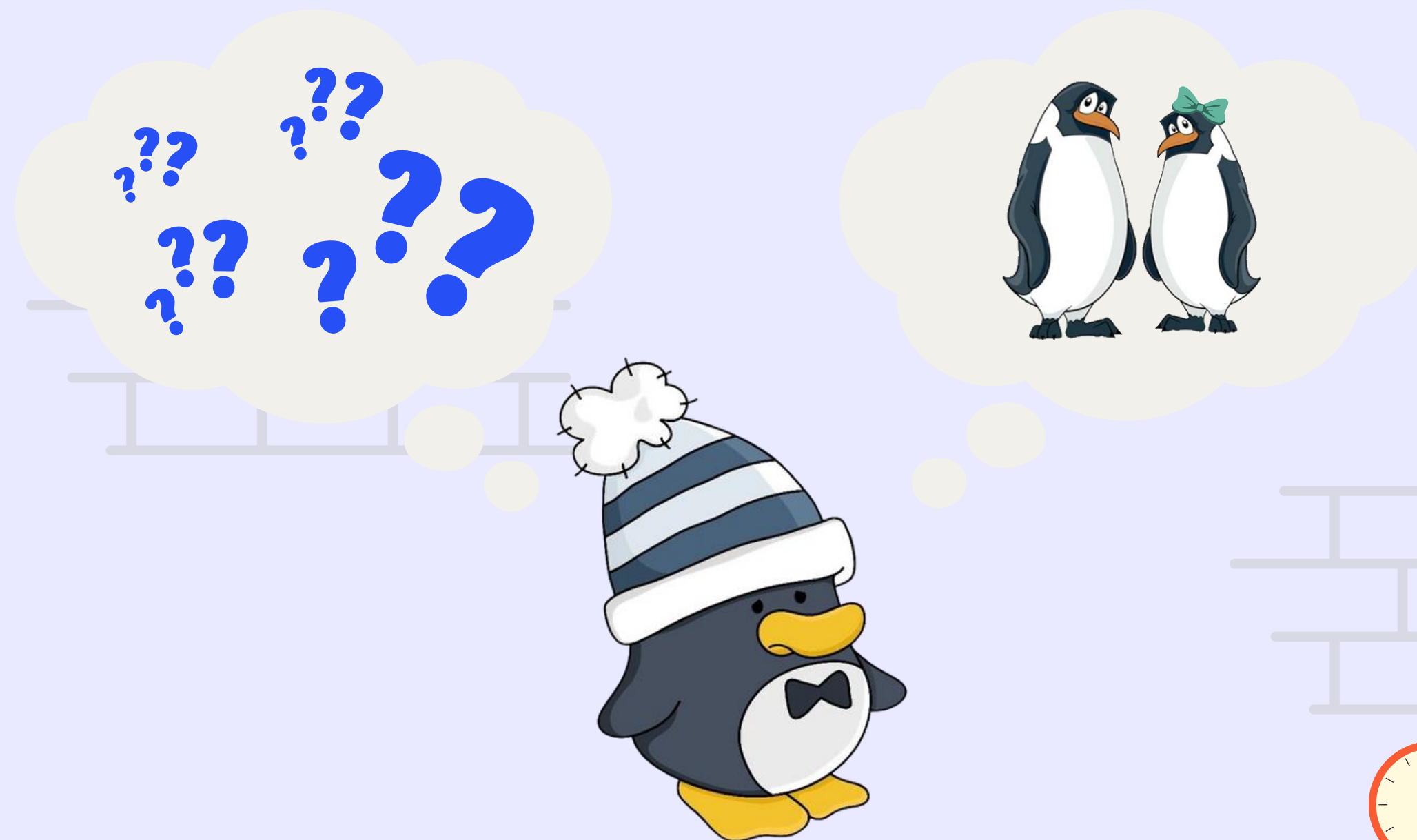
The other player sent a message saying, "Did you see my last message? Shall we meet up?"

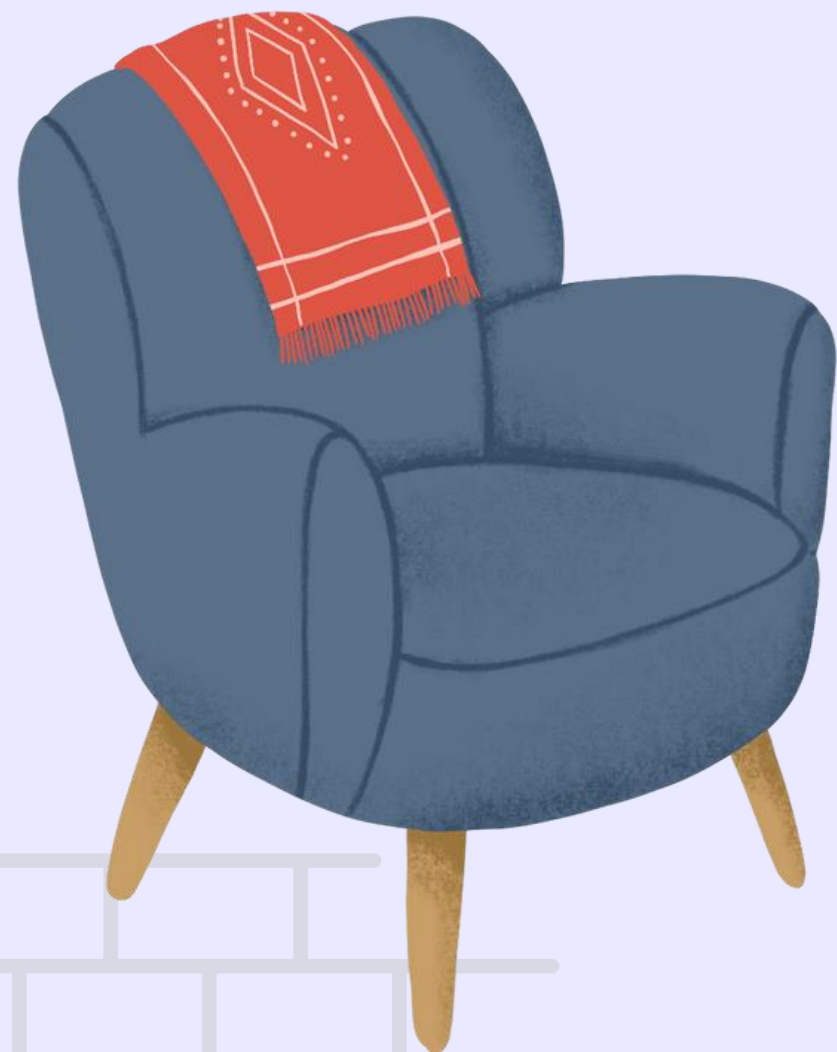

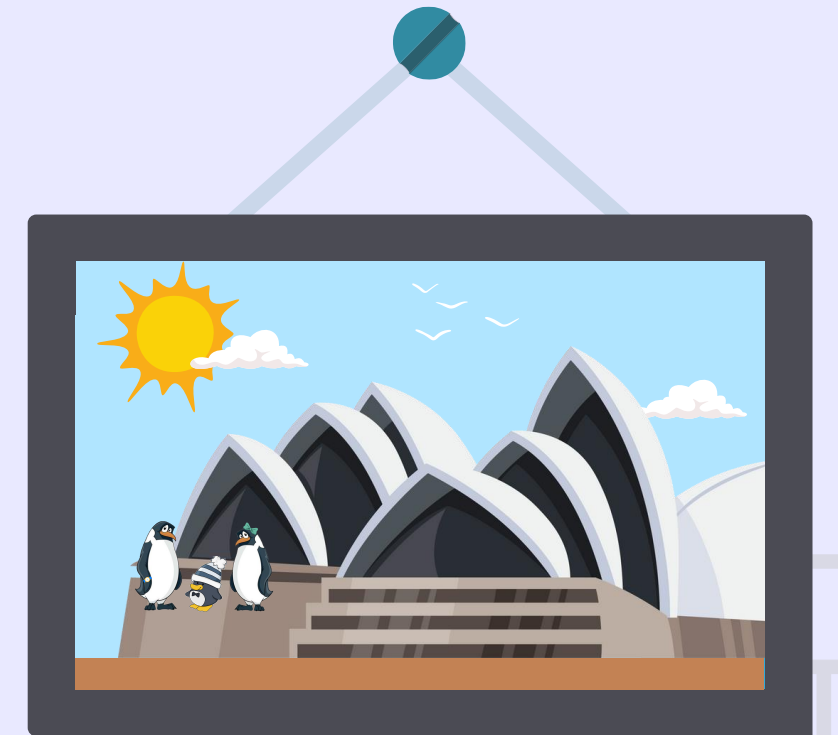


"Daddy! Mummy!" called Smartie.

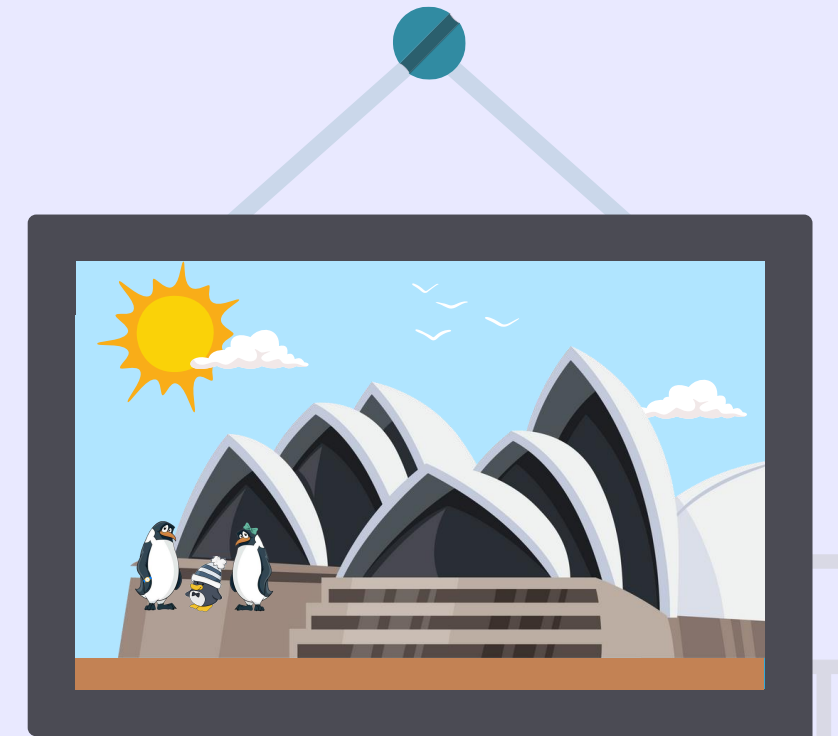
"Someone is asking to meet me, and I don't know them. What shall I do?"



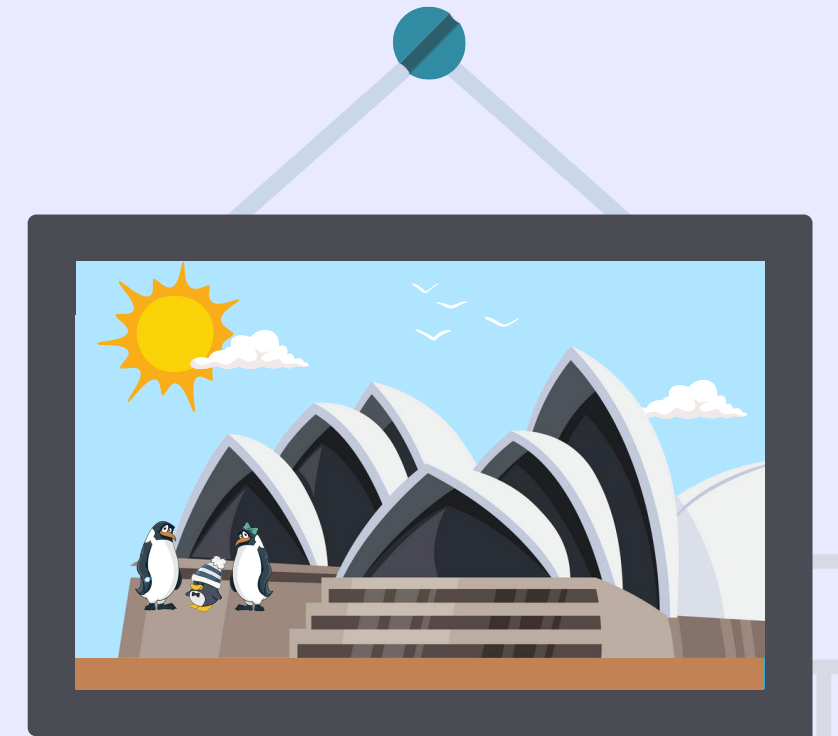

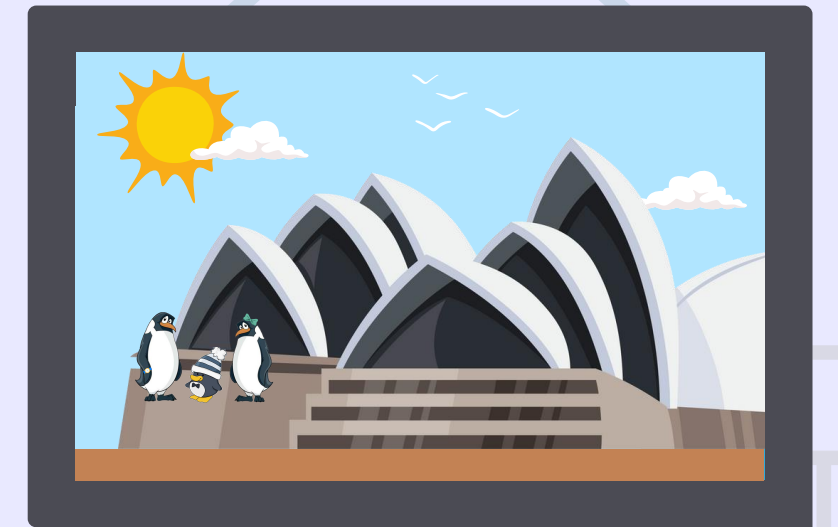
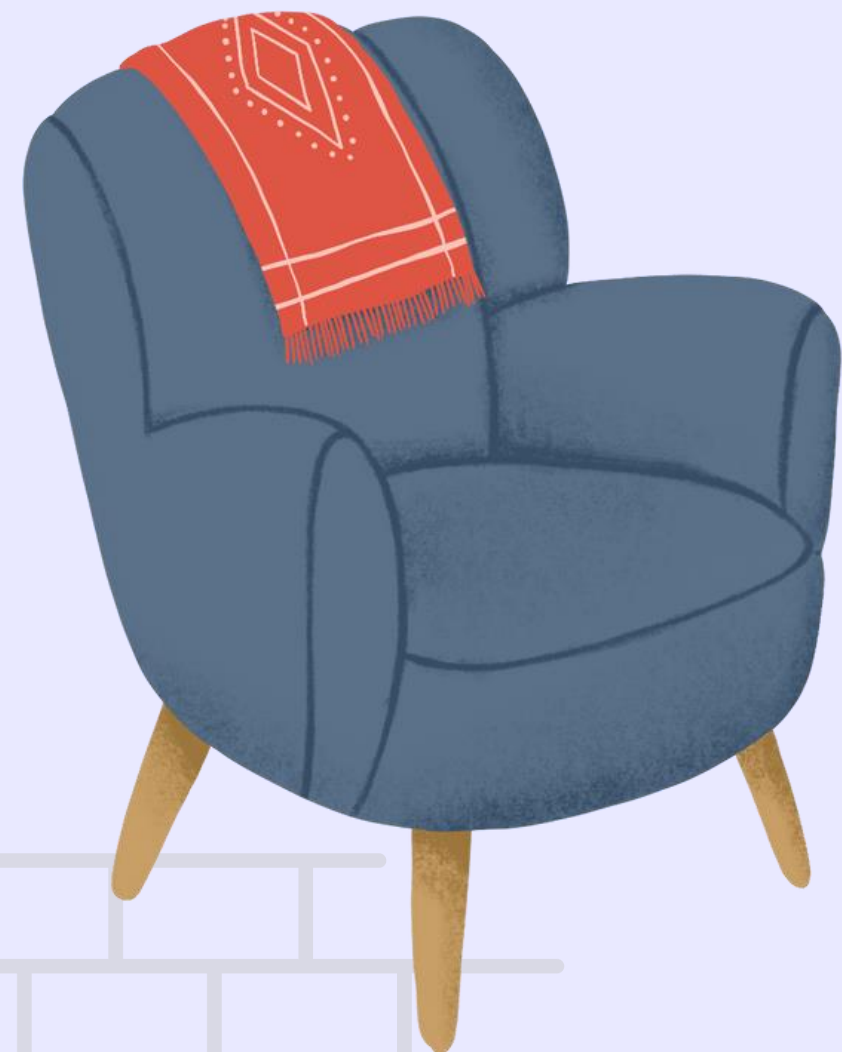
"Smartie, you have been so sensible," said Daddy Penguin. "It is really important to tell an adult if an online friend ever asks for your personal information or to meet up with you."
